THE SALLE CHAPTINI



Every Foundation member who knew the late Edmond Chaptini knows that we lost a dynamic individual and a contributing member of the Charles Tweed Foundation when Edmond died suddenly in the Fall of 2015. St. Joseph's University has embarked upon a project to honor Edmond with the Salle Chaptini. A part of the clinic will be named in Edmond's honor. In order to facilitate this memorial, the university has embarked upon a fund raising drive which will help furnish the clinic space that will be named in Edmond's honor.
